BrainTest is a brief digital self-administered cognitive screening instrument to help identify early changes in cognition.



BrainTest is the exclusive electronic version of the Self-Administered Gerocognitive Exam (SAGE)® created by Dr. Douglas Scharre at The Ohio State University.



Unlike other screening instruments, BrainTest can be self-administered, at home or physician's waiting room.



Each BrainTest is remotely scored, with patient results explained in the app by board certified physicians.



Features easy to understand report card service to track future BrainTest results against established baseline.



Clinical validation study at The Ohio State University evaluated participants using SAGE®, BrainTest, vs. gold standard screening instruments. https://clinicaltrials.gov/ct2/show/NCT02544074



Study presented at AAIC 2017. Validates equivalency of pen-and-paper (SAGE) with BrainTest to detect mild cognitive impairment & early dementias (90% specificity, 71% sensitivity).
